

Helinä Rautavaara Museum's Archive

The collections in the Helinä Rautavaara Museum's digital archive are copyrighted by the museum. Permission is needed for the use of its materials. This text explains the use of the museum's digital photos and digital audio archives.

The photographic and recording collections are Helinä Rautavaara's (1928-1998) recordings. The recording collections are mostly results of her research project, and therefore not intended to commercial use. The museum wants to promote the use of CC- (Creative Commons) licensing, and part of the photographic materials are, thus, free to use. The Helinä Rautavaara Museum's collections ought to be mentioned as the source of material.

It means that the photos published on the web page cannot be copied, forwarded or published without the permission of the rights holder.

Helinä Rautavaara Museum publishes audio clips from the museum's digital archives. They are mostly results of the young Helinä Rautavaara's research project, and therefore not intended to commercial use. They can be used according to the CC 4.0 BY-NC-SA license (Attribution - Noncommercial – ShareAlike).
